2 Cor. 5:13-14

- 1) Room Capacity
Housing is based on quad room occupancy (four people per room).
- 2) Rooms Not Filled to Capacity
Due to the fact that the hotel charges a set rate for each room, regardless of how many people are occupying it, if you are unable to fill your rooms to capacity, additional housing fees apply. (This includes early registrants). In order to keep your costs as low as possible, the fee for each person to participate in the Event is based on having four people in a room. If you only have three people in a room, \$50 will be added to your total registration fee. If you only have two people in a room, \$100 will be added to your total registration fee. If you only have one person in a room, \$150 will be added to your total registration fee. These fees apply to each room not filled to capacity.
- 3) Room Type
In general you can expect to receive a room with two double beds in it. In rare situations the hotel provides some king rooms. We will do our best to accommodate your specific room needs.
- 4) How will rooms be assigned?
We will assign specific people and room numbers to your group. You will have a chance in the confirmation stage to re-arrange people assignments. Rooms neither are guaranteed to be next door to each other; however, each youth group will be housed as close together in the hotel as possible. Specific room numbers and keys will be provided when you check in at the registration table in the hotel on Thursday.
- 5) Who can be in a room?
Persons assigned to a room must be the same sex, unless a married couple purchased their own room.
- 6) Adult Leaders in the Rooms
 - a. We strongly recommend bringing at least one adult for every 8 youth in attendance. We understand that congregations have various policies regarding adults and youth in the same room and while we recommend (but do not require) that you have an adult in each room, we understand that this may not be possible for some congregations. We understand and support congregational policies in order to make it safe for everyone to attend. Please do not let our recommendation to have an adult in each room hinder your decision in coming.
 - b. The local congregation is responsible for their choice of Adult Leaders.
 - c. The local congregation is liable for the conduct of the Adult Leaders with whom it chooses to entrust its young people.
- 7) Do we have to stay in the hotel?
Yes, all participants are to stay at the gathering hotel. Your registrations include the hotel rooms and can not be separated.
